Avoid Long Waits. Schedule an Office Visit Appointment Now!

Office visit appointments are now available each week for your convenience to schedule on your MyMC Page. By scheduling an appointment and letting us know your reason for the visit in advance, will cut down on your wait time. If you do not wish to make an appointment, you may still access MC services during office hours, but wait times may be longer.

NOTE: First-time agreement signing students must visit the office between 9:00 a.m.—12 p.m. Monday—Thursday.

Have You Completed Your 2017-18 FAFSA?

In order to sign your fall 2017 student agreement, you must have a completed and official FAFSA with the Financial Aid Office at your school. If you have not completed the 2017-18 FAFSA yet, we strongly encourage you to go to fafsa.gov ASAP! Remember, use 2015 tax information to complete the application. Monitor your Student Self-Service or ULink account to complete additional steps with the Financial Aid office to prevent a delay in signing your agreement.

Summer/Fall 2017 Tuition Deadlines and Payment Information

Now is the time to sign your summer and/or fall agreements by your school's tuition deadline. Doing so, prevents you paying for late fees, being dropped from your classes or receiving a hold on your account. Remember, you are responsible for paying all fees and ineligible tuition costs by the tuition deadline listed below. If you are unable to sign your agreement and pay your fees and uncovered tuition costs on or before the tuition deadline, you will need to pay the balance in full or contact the Bursar's office to set up a payment plan.
