MC Information

Have You Signed Your Fall 2017 Student Agreement Yet?

Time is running out to sign your fall 2017 student agreement by your school's tuition deadline. If you do not sign by the tuition deadline, you may be dropped from your classes, be assessed late and reinstatement fees, and have a hold placed on your account.

Fall 2017 Tuition Deadlines:

JCTC:	Aug. 11
UofL:	July 28 (students registered by June 30) Aug. 25 (students registered after July 1)

Schedule an office visit appointment on your MyMC Page to avoid long wait times Monday-Thursday. You may still access MC services during office hours without an appointment, but wait times may be longer.

NOTE: First-time agreement signing students must visit the office between 9:00 a.m.—12 p.m. Monday—Thursday.

Have You Completed Your 2017-18 FAFSA?

In order to sign your fall 2017 student agreement, you must have a completed and official FAFSA with the Financial Aid Office at your school. If you have not completed the 2017-18 FAFSA yet, we strongly encourage you to go to fafsa.gov ASAP! Remember, use 2015 tax information to complete the application. Monitor your Student Self-Service or ULink account to complete additional steps with the Financial Aid office to prevent a delay in signing your agreement.

CAPP Completion for Summer/Fall 2017

If you need to complete a CAPP requirement to sign your fall 2017 agreement, you must contact a student development counselor to schedule an appointment to attend one of the few remaining Friday morning CAPP Blitzes at the JCTC-Downtown MC office.
