





Program Overview

What is Metropolitan College?

Metropolitan College is a joint education-workforceeconomic development initiative among the following partners:

UPS

University of Louisville

Jefferson Community and Technical College
Louisville Metro Government
Kentucky State Government

The partnership provides eligible Kentucky residents access to a tuition-free, post-secondary education and outstanding employment opportunities while working third shift at UPS.

Benefit Eligibility Requirements

- Work part-time, 3rd shift at UPS in the Next Day Air Operation
- Complete the FAFSA each year and be a US citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Register for classes
- Pass classes with a C- or better
- Sign an MC Student Agreement each semester and satisfy the semester work commitment dates
 - Fall: December 31
 - **Spring**: May 31 (tuition and books); June 30 (academic bonuses)
 - Summer: September 30

MC @ UofL: Admission Requirement

To participate in MC at UofL, you must have a:

- 3.0 cumulative high school GPA AND
- 21 ACT/1060 SAT composite score

Beginning fall 2020, MC will consider a first-time MC student's ACT/SAT Superscore of 21/1060 or higher if the minimum ACT/SAT composite score is not met.

Any MC UofL student who does not meet this requirement is encouraged to speak with a Student Development Counselor for further information.

Don't Meet the Eligibility Requirement for MC @ UofL?

Option 1



Attend JCTC and transfer to UofL **after** you reach the 60 transferable hours or obtain an Associate degree. You can also take advantage of ULtra (JCTC to UofL Transfer Program).

Option 2



Attend UofL and take advantage of the UPS Earn and Learn program until you reach 60 hours and then contact a Student Development Counselor about joining the MC program.

Petition for an exception to the MC/UofL Admission requirement.

Submitting a petition does not guarantee approval.





Payment Process

TUITION

PAYMENT FORMULA

50% tuition paid by UPS **50% tuition** paid by grant and/or MC/UPS if there are no grants or insufficient fund for the full half of tuition

= **100% tuition** (paid at Kentucky resident undergraduate rate)

All fees are the responsibility of the student.

These fees include but are not limited to housing, mandatory student fees, online course fees, lab fees, electronic books, etc.

EXAMPLE C: \$2088 TUITION BILL

\$1,044 paid by UPS

\$500 paid by Pell Grant (no other grants)

\$544 paid by MC/UPS (remaining after grants)

Deferment vs Reimbursement

Tuition Deferment: Transfer By July to Defer Payment by Tuition Deadline

- Student agreement signed by the semester tuition deadline
- Student pays fees and any tuition costs not covered by MC by tuition deadline
- MC pays eligible tuition 4-6 weeks after work commitment date satisfied

Tuition Reimbursement: Transfer Eligibility After Tuition Deadline

- Student pays tuition and fees by semester tuition deadline
- Student signs agreement by semester signing deadline
- MC pays eligible tuition 4-6 weeks after work commitment date satisfied; student receives reimbursement through JCTC refund process

MC Success Tips

Balancing School and 3rd Shift Schedule

Part-Time to Full-Time Enrollment

First Semester

Enroll 10 credit hours or less

Second Semester

Enroll 12+ credit hours

New MC Student Grading Policy


Students who are enrolled for 10 credit hours or less by the 100% drop/add date at their institution will be eligible for payment for courses completed with a "D" or better during the first agreement semester. (Semester and Milestone bonuses are excluded from this policy.)

Note: Grades of C- or better required after first MC agreement.

We know that students who work third shift and who maintain a high GPA have several factors in common. Review the following tips for Metropolitan College to learn how you can ensure your success in the MC program. Feel free to contact a MC Student Development Counselor if you have any questions or need additional guidance in planning.

Limit First Semester Enrollment

- UofL students should register for 9 credit hours or less <u>and</u> the 1 credit hour orientation course. JCTC students should register for no more than 3 classes: FYE105 and 2 proficiency areas (i.e. math and English). Both UofL and JCTC offer Metropolitan College cohort orientation courses taught by MC staff to provide additional support and guidance for the first term.
- Beginning in the fall 2019 semester students who sign their first MC agreement and adhere
 to part-time enrollment recommendations of enrolling in 10 credit hours or less, will be
 eligible for payment for courses completed with a D grade during the first agreement.

UPS: Benefits of Being a Package Handler



- Health, dental, vision, prescription, and life insurance coverage after 9 months of employment
- Paid vacations and holidays after one year of employment
- Ability to purchase UPS stock
- Develop essential work skills
- UPS Education Representatives available during work shift to answer questions and provide support

UPS: STW Transfer to Night Steps

- Transfer date is selected & provided by Training Department
- Transfer dates will be July 6 and July 13
- Once date selected, allow two weeks for GEMS to update
- STW students who pass 2 JCTC classes C or better, enrolled in Metro College & transfer to nights receive \$500 bonus
- STW students hired for second semester who pass 1 JCTC class C or better, enrolled in Metro College & transfer to nights receive \$250 bonus

- Prepare to sign your first student agreement by reviewing online modules accessed through your MyMC Page
- □ Schedule an Appointment to Sign MC Student Agreement
- •10-15-minute appointment provided in-person or virtually
- □ Develop a Plan to Pay for Tuition and Fees by Tuition Deadline
- Tuition deferment vs. tuition reimbursement
