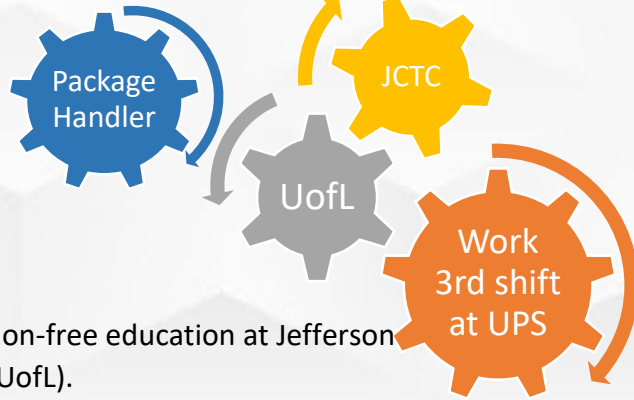


Attending JCTC or UofL?

Eligibility

The Metropolitan College (MC) program offers an opportunity for a tuition-free education at Jefferson Community and Technical College (JCTC) or the University of Louisville (UofL).

Transfer to nights after high school graduation and work as a 3rd shift, part-time package handler at UPS Worldport to receive paid tuition – up to the full-time undergraduate, in-state rate - at either JCTC or UofL each semester for eligible grades.

UofL MC Admissions requirement | To utilize MC benefits at UofL, you must meet one of the following criteria:

- Cumulative 3.0 high school GPA or greater and a 21 composite or Superscore.
- 60 transferable college credit hours or have earned an associate degree
- Cumulative 3.3 high school GPA or greater, no ACT/SAT test score required.

Steps to Complete **BEFORE** You Transfer to Night



- 1 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**
 - studentaid.gov (Add both School Codes: UofL 001999; JCTC 06961)
 - **Goal Date:** Application opens Oct. 1

(Must be a U.S. citizen or federal student aid eligible non-citizen to participate in MC program)
- 2 Apply for Admission to School**
 - UofL: louisville.edu/admissions/apply (See MC UofL Requirement)
 - JCTC: jefferson.kctcs.edu/admissions
 - **Goal Date:** Beginning Nov. 1
- 3 Optional: MC Students Attending UofL Apply to MC Themed Housing Community - Apply early**
 - louisville.edu/housing (UofL housing not included in MC benefits)
 - **Goal Date:** Beginning November 1
- 4 If Attending UofL and Not Meeting MC Requirements: Submit Petition**
 - forms.metro-college.com/petition
 - **Goal Date:** After April 1
- 5 Sign up to Attend New Student Orientation and Register for Classes**
 - UofL: louisville.edu/newcards/first-year
 - JCTC: jefferson.kctcs.edu/admissions/meet-your-admissions-team/orientation.aspx

Helpful Tips:

 - Register for late afternoon and/or evening classes
 - Sessions fill up quickly, so reserve your spot as soon as possible for the May/June sessions.

Part-time to Full-Time Enrollment

First Semester

Enroll 10 credit hours or less

Second Semester

Enroll 12+ credit hours

New MC Student Grade Policy

Students who are enrolled in 10 credit hours or less by the 100% drop/add date at their institution will be eligible for payment for courses completed with a "D-" or better during the first semester only. Semester and milestone bonuses are excluded from this policy.

Note: Grades of C- or better required after first MC agreement.

Steps to Complete **AFTER** You Transfer to Nights

1. Complete **Employment Verification** at verify.metro-college.com/
 - a. You will receive an email confirming your employment within 3-5 business days.
2. Complete the **Student Transition Program (STP)** modules.
 - a. Log in to My MC at mymc.metro-college.com. (**Access to the MyMC page is granted after employment verification is complete**)
 - b. Select "STP" under the CAPP Requirements section and complete the 1-2 hour online orientation.
3. Schedule an appointment to **Sign Your First MC Student Agreement**. (**You will be prompted to schedule an appointment after STP is complete**)
 - a. Must sign agreement by school's tuition deadline to defer payment.
 - b. Appointments will be extremely limited after Aug. 1.
